I would like to add that on 14.04.94 in the afternoon, I was at Bujumbura airport. A French aircraft arrived and Burundi policemen were opposed to anyone getting off. The French aircraft had to leave with its passengers and cargo. Afterwards I discussed it with the Burundi Colonel who accompanied the aircraft as far as Bukavu (Zaire). There the aircraft was unloaded before returning to Bujumbura. A Burundi policeman told me that the passengers were Rwandans, "undesirable" on Burundi soil. They could no longer go to Bangui. The rumour ran that Georges RUGGIU, the presenter of RTL M was on board.

To my knowledge there were certainly no missiles with the FAR. Perhaps the Presidential Guard which was armed by Zaire and about which the French were concerned.
