The Ministry for Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation of the Rwandan Republic presents its compliments to the Embassy of the Democratic People's Republic of Korea in Kigali and, following its verbal memo n° 968/16.00/CAB/AP of 13 November 1990, has the honour of seeking military aid from the Korean Government.

The Rwandan Government remains convinced that the Korean Government is going to offer it its support in these times where Rwanda continues to face attacks from the Inyenzi-Inkotanyi attackers, always coming from the outside.

The aid thus sought is broken down as follows:

- Location Unit (small detection radar for Obus launch points)	4
 <u>b) Clothing + Equipment</u>	
- Individual tents	30,000
- Platoon tents	600
- MROP clothing and equipment for 10 battalions	

The Ministry would appreciate it if the Embassy would pass on this request to the competent authorities of its country.

The Ministry for Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation of the Rwandan Republic thanks the Embassy of the Democratic People's Republic of Korea in Kigali in advance for its friendly intervention and would like to take this opportunity to reiterate the assurance of its highest consideration.
